Strictly speaking, the salmonids of interest for aquaculture are those of the subfamily Salmoninae, as the family Salmonidae also includes the whitefishes (Coregoninae) and graylings (Thymallinae) (Nelson 1994).

Lake Thingvallavatn supports four trophic morphs of Arctic charr, *Salvelinus alpinus* (L.); two of the morphs are benthic (small and large benthivorous charr) one exploits pelagic waters (planktivorous charr) and the fourth is found in both habitats (piscivorous charr).

The intrageneric hybrid is of the genus *Salvelinus* and, hence, is most properly known as a char or charr. In some locales, the fish is referred to as the wendigo. Although the hybrid is genetically stable and is, theoretically, capable of reproducing, splake reproduction is extremely rare, for behavioural reasons, outside the hatchery environment.
