Then either go by Sunny-16 or take a shot then adjust per shooting preference: ideally, with 1/3 or 1/2 stop one way or other depending on which you dont want to clip too much in your scene.

Using Manual Focus Lenses on Nikon DSLR Cameras

Yes, the D5000 has a Rangefinder option. When in manual focus mode, this replaces the exposure meter in your viewfinder with a rangefinder meter. If the markings appear to the left, focus is in front of the subject. If the markings appear to the right, focus is behind the subject.

Does my SLR have an indicator to help me use manual focus ...

For those of you who are considering using the D7000 with your stash of manual-focus AI or AI-S lenses, I'm happy to report that it works better than you might expect. You can program in the focal length and maximum aperture so they'll appear in the EXIF data, but even if you don't you can focus using either the manual focus indicator in the viewfinder or Live View on the LCD.
