If an item has no author, start the citation with the article title. When an article has one to seven authors, all authors' names are cited in the References List entry. When an article has eight or more authors list the first six authors followed by three spaced ellipse points (...), and then the last author's name.

Citing an online journal article When citing an online journal article, first look for a DOI, as this is more stable and less likely to change than a URL.

How to Cite a Journal Article in MLA | Format & Examples

For an APA citation for a journal article with 2 to 20 authors, use a comma between all of the author names. Place an ampersand (&) before the final author's name. For an article with 21 or more authors, list the names of the first 19 authors and use a comma between all of the names.

APA Journal Citations: Everything You Need to Know

Paraphrase – Take the information from a specific paragraph or section of the article and rewrite it in your own words.

Summarize – Write a broad overview of the section or the article in your own words.

Quote – Repeat the exact words used by the author using quotation marks.

How to cite a journal in MLA | in-text & full citation ...

For the journal title, capitalize all major words in the title, including an initial article (e.g., The, A, An). Do not capitalize prepositions or articles in the middle of a journal title (e.g., of, the, an, etc.). Italicize the journal title. After the journal title, add the journal volume number and be sure to italicize the volume number.

APA style dictates that authors are named with their last name followed by their initials; publication year goes between parentheses, followed by a period. The title of the article is in sentence-case, meaning only the first word and proper nouns in the title are capitalized.

In Harvard style, to reference a journal article, you need the author name (s), the year, the article title, the journal name, the volume and issue numbers, and the page range on which the article appears. If you accessed the article online, add a DOI (digital object identifier) if available.

APA Journal Citation | APA Format

Journal articles frequently have multiple authors. Author names should be listed in the order they appear at the head of the article (not in alphabetical order). In your notes, list up to three authors in full. When there are four or more authors, list only the first, followed by “ et al. ” (Latin for “and others”).

Cite a Journal Article in Chicago Style | Format & Examples

Article from an Online Periodical with no DOI Assigned. If an online scholarly journal article has no DOI and is published on a website, include the URL. If an online scholarly article has no DOI and is published on a database, do not include a URL or any database information.

Reference List: Electronic Sources // Purdue Writing Lab

If the journal article has a digital object identifier (DOI), include this in your reference. If there is no DOI and you have accessed the article electronically, include the web address of the journal's homepage in which the article was published in your reference. You can check if an article has a DOI at CrossRef.
